### **RANDOM DRAW OF PRECINCTS - PLAN E COUNT**

The random draw of precincts required by Mass. General Laws Chapter 54A, Section 8 will take place at 689 Massachusetts Avenue STE 1, Cambridge, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room during a meeting of the Board of Election Commissioners on **Wednesday, October 15, 2025, at 11:00 a.m.**

### **OBSERVERS AT EARLY VOTING SITES AND POLLING PLACES**

Any candidate may have observers at the polls on Election Day. It is the candidate's responsibility to instruct the observer/s not to interfere with the election process in any way. Observers are to have no interaction with voters. All observers must comply with the applicable laws and regulations and observations must be done in conformity with the instructions of local officials, or they will be asked to leave. Given any space limitations, election officials may limit the number of observers in a polling place or at an early voting location and ask that they cooperate in collecting information.

The Voting List will be organized by ward and precinct in street order, within street and number order, alphabetically by last name of voter. If names and addresses are not being called out loudly enough for the observer to hear, the observer should bring it to the attention of the Warden and Clerk. If the problem persists, call the Election Commission. Please call or email the Election Commission if you plan to have observers at the polls and have questions.

### **EARLY VOTING AND IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING ELECTIONEERING POLICY**

Please be advised that there is a prohibition on "electioneering" within 150' of the designated entrance of an early voting location or in-person absentee voting location. The policy is included for your convenience.
